- **From the USA: Announcing National Center for Interprofessional Practice and Education Operations Team.** The new National Center for Interprofessional Practice and Education has announced its operations team comprising of Barbara Brandt, Ph.D., director; Frank Cerra, M.D., senior advisor and interim deputy director; Jennifer Kertz, MPP, center administrator; and Chris Roberts, strategic communications consultant. "This core group is leading planning and implementation for the new center, bringing other experienced leaders into the conversation as appropriate. This is the first phase of the team. Other members will be added as the center develops and matures," according to Barbara Brandt, director. - **Interprofessional Education Paper makes an IMPACT** Dr Sundari Joseph and Dr Lesley Diack from Robert Gordon University's Faculty of Health and Social Care co-authored an award-winning paper with Aberdeen GP Dr Fiona Garton from the University of Aberdeen and Jenni Haxton, practice education facilitator, from NHS Grampian. Entitled 'Interprofessional Education in Practice,' the paper was recently published in the internationally renowned journal 'Clinical Teacher' and has received an IMPACT Award for being the most downloaded article from the magazine's website in 2012. - **Collaboration with the Police.** In January of this year the research team in Aberdeen were awarded a grant from the Scottish Institute for Policing Research (SIPR) for a project titled "Interagency adult support and protection practice of police and health and social care professionals: a realistic evaluation approach". This study comprises an interdisciplinary collaboration between two Scottish Higher Education Institutions (Robert Gordon University and the University of Aberdeen), the Scottish Police College and Grampian. - **Collaboration across Scottish Universities.** Following on from presenting at the international Interprofessional All Together Better Health Conference VI Kobe, Japan in October 2012, collaborative working led to two further funded projects, namely Health Care Team Challenge and SASAKAWA Foundation. A conglomeration of representatives from Scottish universities, including Dr Sundari Joseph and Dr Lesley Diack from Robert Gordon University led by Jenny Miller AHP Lead for Practice Education at NHS Education Scotland (NES) received funding from NES to introduce and pilot Health Care Team Challenge, a recognised IPE activity for students in many countries but new to Scottish Universities delivering IPE.
